His life is not marked by irritability, and it did not culminate in mental and psychic collapse as did the life of Nietzsche. Probably life was easier for a man of genius in Russia than in Germany - there are wider spaces there, more freedom, more tenderness between man and man, less materialism, less selfishness, less to send one mad. Solovyof came from a happy home and of a literary family. His father, Serge Mikhalovitch Solovyof, was a historian; his mother, a Little Russian of old family and culture, was proud to remind her children of a kinsman who had been...
